About the School

The Hijas de Jesus sisters first came to the Philippines on June 18, 1932. They acquired a permit from the government to open Nazareth School starting with three elementary grade levels, adding one level each year until it was able to graduate its first batch of high school students in 1956. Nazareth School started out as a Catholic School offering basic education run by the Hijas de Jesus Congregation until its merging with NU on March 23, 2013.

In 2008, the SM Group of Companies (the largest retail business in the Philippines) acquired majority ownership of the National University (NU) which offers tertiary education. In 2013, the SM Group of Companies acquired ownership of Nazareth School and on March 23, 2013, NU Basic Education merged with Nazareth School and is now known as **NU Nazareth School (NUNS)**.

Senior High School Program

The Senior High School program provides students with a holistic education and industry experience learning.



Accountancy, Business, and Management (ABM)

The ABM strand prepares future business professionals to be creative, analytic, organized, and innovative. ABM subjects introduce students to accounting, finance, and business management concepts.

Students who choose this path will be prepared to become future accountants, entrepreneurs, and business leaders vital to the local and national economy's progress, growth, and development. ABM courses are a combination of application and practical skills that allow students to be familiar with the corporate environment and be globally competitive.



Science, Technology, Engineering, and Mathematics (STEM)

The STEM strand is designed to prepare students to utilize science, math, engineering, and technology to solve real-life problems to advance national development and contribute to world progress.

Students who choose this path are exposed to skills in analyzing data, conducting research, combining academics with technology, and innovation. STEM courses are based on learner-centered curricula in which students learn global skills, competencies, and knowledge, including work and life values prerequisites to successful career paths.



HUMSS

Humanities and Social Sciences (HUMSS)

The HUMSS strand is designed to expand the students' skills in understanding individuals and society. It develops a deeper understanding of societal issues and the dynamics of human conditions.

Students who choose this route will have a better appreciation and knowledge of culture, society, politics, art, and literature that provides a closer look into the interplay of different aspects of society. HUMSS courses equip students to understand various people's life perspectives, analyze and create objective opinions about individuals, organizations, politics, culture, technology, and religious beliefs.



GAS

General Academic Strand (GAS)

The GAS strand is designed to prepare students who are more disposed to general areas than specialized fields. Electives are chosen from the different strands, including Humanities, Social Sciences, Applied Economics, Disaster Preparedness, Organization, and Management.

Students who choose this route are trained to think systematically, critically, and innovatively. GAS courses expose students to different electives in Social Sciences, Business and Management, which facilitates the learner to decide on which program to pursue in college.



Junior High School Program

The Junior High School Program provides a holistic education that balances the learners' cognitive, physical, social, emotional, and spiritual development in a Christian and rewarding work environment. The program offers an array of learning experiences that develops scientifically and technologically-minded, value-laden and communitarian learners who will apply communication skills in expressing one's stand on various social and contemporary issues and will show respect for the ideas and opinions of others. The program further allows learners to demonstrate their skills innovatively through various activities that would enable them to appreciate the value of oneself.

Grades 4 to 6 Program

The NU Nazareth School Grades 4 to 6 program provides a holistic education for the overall development of the child. The program aims to develop a student who thinks critically, upholds a strong value-laden personality that advocates peace, understands the importance of meaningful connections with other people, shows confidence in expressing one's ideas and creativity, and models kindness through St. Candida's ways and teachings.

The program also allows for students to showcase their skills and talents through the different activities and after-school programs that cultivates and lets them express themselves as individuals. Lastly, the program provides support for the students' mental and emotional health and wellness.

Nursery to Grade 3 Program

The NU Nazareth School Kinder-Grade 3 program provides initial educational experiences that fosters balance between their cognitive, physical, social, emotional, and spiritual development through a self-contained teaching set up. The K-3 program's focus on literacy and holistic learning serves as the foundation for literature-based teaching and curriculum integration. Furthermore, the program focuses on the cultivation of a Nazalian with desirable attitudes and behavior geared towards personal growth in freedom, discipline, and responsibility and the formation of a personal awareness of God's love and goodness through Catholic and Mother Candida's teaching.

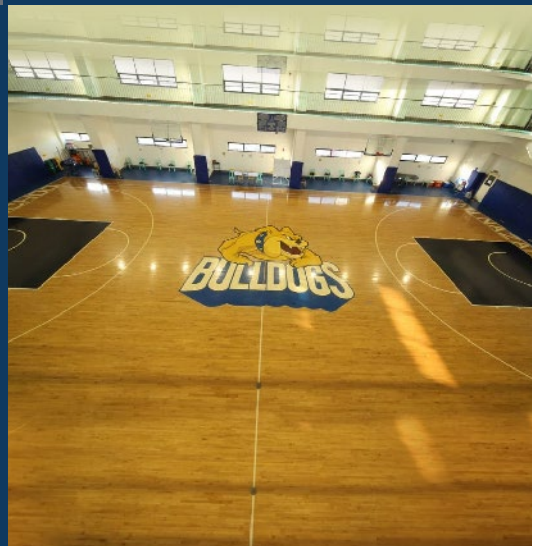
