September 7, 2022, the Social Science Department, along with the Officials of Barangay 407, Zone 42 of Manila, and Representatives from the National University-Manila Community COMEX convened for a consultative meeting to discuss the barangay-level program. The meeting began with a brief overview of the agenda followed by formal introductions of the attendees.

The core group ensured from the outset the meeting focused on youth-related programs. Subsequently, the Barangay Chairman responded to the numerous activities they organize in their community, such as the Film Showing, and Day Care Activities.

The proposal for "Competency Training" originated from the core group and was presented to the Barangay Chairman to enhance the knowledge of potential Sangguniang Kabataan candidates and the incumbent SK Chairman. As observed by the Barangay Captain, the Sangguniang Kabataan officials still need improvements in terms of their role, responsibilities as well as their powers as part of the Barangay unit.

It was evident that there is a certain minimal level that points out some lack of competency. This can be attributed to certain policies being undermined when it comes to actual implementation vis-à-vis the understanding of the youth barangay executives of complicated work delegation and functions amongst key officials. It was decided that the Sangguniang Kabataan and the potential SK Candidates, but also the Barangay Kagawads in which they serve, shall participate in the Competency Training.

Before the conclusion of the meeting, it was added that not only Barangay 407 but also the 11 other barangays under Zone 42 of Manila to participate in the dissemination of the information to the community, as they have said, the more participants, the better the impact of the training will be. As it is the standard operating procedure, the said gathering should be first approved by the COMEX. The target age of the participants is from 18-24 years old.
