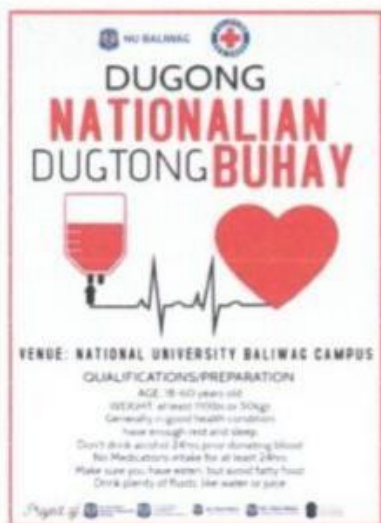

The pandemic seriously affected the supply of safe and quality blood in the province of Bulacan. The number of demands for blood transfusion has not actually reduced but unbelievably increase during the crisis.

Routine blood donor screening measures- which may include travel deferrals- are already in place to prevent individuals with clinical respiratory infections from donating blood and ensuring the safety of the blood supply. It aims to:
