I. Context

The School of Tourism and Hospitality Management Community Extension Team organized the Project SEED which stands for **S**olo-Parents **E**mpowerment towards **E**conomic **D**evelopment last November 2023. This project aims to empower solo parents by teaching them how to prepare and cook banana chips which can be added source of income for their families.

The participants are 20 solo parents (Mothers and fathers who served as breadwinners of their families and have no assistance from their partners). The project has the main objective of capacitating the solo parents with another source of entrepreneurial activity that they can pursue at the comfort of their homes.

The project was conducted in partnership with Plaridel Local Government Unit of Plaridel, Bulacan.

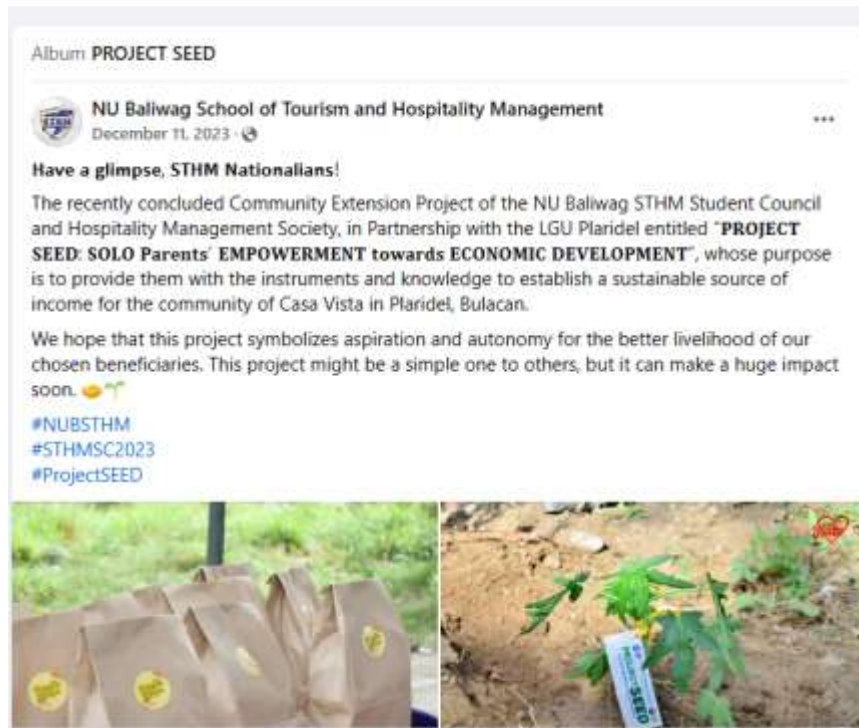
1. Directory of Participants

To ensure that the participants will apply what they learned from the initial activity, the directory of participants was created with their specific addresses and contact information.


